

Placement in Employment

The Higher Education Act of 1965 (HEA) requires institutions receiving Title IV funding make available, to current and prospective students, information regarding the placement in employment of, and types of employment obtained by graduates on the institution's degree or certificate programs.

Additionally, OC's institutional accrediting body, the Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (ABHES), requires schools to collect and submit graduation and job placement rates each academic year. In keeping with these requirements, Orion College publishes the following Placement in Employment statistics, using the formula below:

$$(\text{Placed in Field} + \text{Placed in Related Field}) \div (\text{Graduated} - \text{Unavailable}) = \text{Placement Percentage}$$
